To all 68th Scout Group families:

All Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Venturers, Scouters and parents are requested to participate in our annual Apple Day fundraiser. Apple Day is an important event in the Scouting year. It is the time that we ask Londoners to make a donation to Scouting and we give them an apple in return to thank them. This is a great opportunity to promote Scouting within our community and raise some money to support our group. Last year we had registered 105 youth and 35 volunteer leaders. Apple Day is very important to our group because it helps us raise much needed funds. All the money we raise on Apple Day stays in our group and goes towards purchasing camping equipment, paying for leader training.

For all youth that participate this year, a portion of the profits made will go into their Scout Camp account (1 shift = 1 share; 2 shifts = 2 shares; etc). Monies stored in Scout Camp Accounts can be used to pay for camps, outings and registration.

On Apple Day, Beavers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Parent volunteers of older youth are also needed to drive and help supervise our youth at the sites. The more participants we have, the more money we raise.

What to wear: full uniform and dress appropriately for the weather
What to bring: Beavers and Cubs should bring a small fruit basket to help carry their apples.
